

CONSONANT BLENDS AND DIGRAPHS

What is a Consonant Blend?

When two consonants come together in a word but still make their own sounds, we call that a blend.

Examples:

bl as in blue, **sl** as in sled, **gl**, **br**, **cr**, **dr**, **fr**, **gr**, **tr**, **sk**, **sp**, **st**, **str**,
ng as in sing, **mp** as in camp, **nk**, **lt**, **ft**

What is a Digraph?

Sometimes two consonants come together in a word and make a new sound.

Examples:

ch as in chip,
sh as in sh
wr, **kn**, **th**
