

CONSONANT BLENDS AND DIGRAPHS

What is a Consonant Blend?

When two consonants come together in a word but still make their own sounds, we call that a blend.

Examples:

bl as in blue, sl as in sled, gl, br, cr, dr, fr, gr, tr, sk, sp, st, str, ng as in sing, mp as in camp, nk, lt, ft

What is a Digraph?

Sometimes two consonants come together in a word and make a new sound.

Examples:

ch as in chip, **sh** as in sh

wr, kn, th


