Long vowels say their own names in many words. They have a **special helper called Silent e** that makes them say their own name.

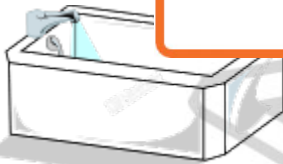
Look at each picture as you say each word. See how the silent e reminds the vowel to say its own name.
