A complete sentence is a group of words in speaking order. The words tell a complete idea. They tell the whole idea. A complete sentence tells who or what the idea is about. It also tells what happens.

Example:

Children play games.
Who? Children
What happens? play games.

Teachers have lessons.
Who? Teachers
What happens? have lessons.

Food is good.
What? Food
What happens?
