What is a Prefix?

A **prefix** is any letter or group of letters that is added to the front of a base word to change the meaning.

Here is a list of some prefixes that change the meaning of a word.

The prefix **re-** means **to do again**. Wrap changes to rewrap.

The prefix **un-** means **not**, or the opposite. Happy changes to unhappy.

The prefix **dis-** means **not**, or the opposite. Obey changes to disobey.

The prefix **pre-** means **before**. Test changes to pretest.
