What is a Suffix?

A suffix is a letter or group of letters added to the end of a word to change its meaning.

To change a word **from singular to plural**, you add the suffix -s or -es.

Examples: boy - boys box - boxes

To change from present to past tense, you add the suffix -ed.

Examples: color - colored

To compare words, you add the suffix -er or -est.

Examples: fast, faster, fastest

Here are n -ness, -ly,



ful, -less,
