What is a Contraction?

A contraction is really two words squeezed together to make a new word. Some of the letters from one or both of the words go away and a special mark called an apostrophe goes in their place.

Examples:

- Do + not = don't (Notice that the o in 'not' is gone. The apostrophe takes its place.)
- Can + not = can't (One n and the o are gone. The apostrophe takes the place of both.)
- It + is = it's
 (The apostrophe takes the place of the i in 'is.')
- They + are = they're
 (The apostrophe takes the place of the a in 'are ')
