-tch: catch, hatch, batch, match, watch, fetch, itch, ditch, pitch, witch, notch, crutch,

-sh: dash, crash, wish, dish, swish, fish, wash, push, bush, crush, brush

-th: bath, math, teeth, tenth, with, cloth, moth, booth, both, with, fifth, month, south, north


