What are Plurals?

Plurals are the words that change a noun to mean more than one.

- You add <u>s</u> to most nouns to make them name more than one.
 Example: one tree, many trees
- You add <u>es</u> to some nouns to make them name more than one.
 Singular nouns that end in s, x, ch, sh must have es added to change to plural. Examples: kiss kisses, ax axes, ranch ranches, wish wishes
- Some nouns change to a new form to make a plural. Examples: child
 children, man men, mouse mice, tooth teeth.
- Some name stay the same in singular or plural. Example: one deer, many d
