What is Past Tense?

Past tense means something happened in the past. It could be many years ago, yesterday, or just a few minutes ago. Verbs change in special ways to show past tense.

- Most verbs that tell about the past end in <u>ed</u>. Example: look looked, want - wanted
- If a verb ends in <u>e</u>, to make the past tense, you drop that e, then add ed. Example: hope hoped
- If a verb has one vowel followed by one consonant, you double the consonant before adding <u>ed</u>. Example: hop hopped.
