

CONSONANT BLENDS

What are Consonant Blends?

Consonant blends are two or more letters that work together. When a word is sounded out, both of the letters in a consonant blend are heard. For example, in the word small, the s and the m are blended together in sounding out the sm.

Examples

The consonant blends in each of these words are printed in bold print:


