

R-CONTROLLED VOWELS

What are R-Controlled Vowels?

R-controlled vowels are vowels in which the **r** following the vowel changes the sound of the vowel. Sometimes, we call the **r** *a bossy letter* because it *takes over* and *bosses* the vowels around!

Examples

- 1] In the word car, the \mathbf{r} following the vowel \mathbf{a} changes or controls the vowel sound.
- 2] In the word bird, the $\bf r$ following the vowel $\bf i$ changes or controls the vowel sound.
- 3] In the word purse, the $\bf r$ following the vowel $\bf u$ changes or controls the vowel sound.
