What is the Difference Between a Fact and an Opinion?

A fact can be proven. An opinion is the way that someone feels about a subject and it cannot be proven. Being able to tell the difference between a fact and an opinion will improve your reading comprehension.

Examples

Fact: Asia is the largest continent.

Checking an on-line or printed encyclopedia can prove this statement.

Opinion: Asia is the prettiest continent.

This statement **cannot be proven**. One person may agree that Asia is the prettiest continent, while another person may think that Africa is the prettiest continent.
