

SIMPLE SUBJECT AND PREDICATE OF A SENTENCE

What are the Subject and the Predicate of a Sentence?

The **subject** of a sentence is **who** or **what** the sentence is about. The **predicate** of a sentence is the **doing** or **action** part of the sentence.

The predicate tells us what the subject of the sentence is doing.

Example

Haley sat down at her computer.

Which word or words are the subject of the sentence?
