

APPROPRIATE END MARKS IN SENTENCES

How Should a Sentence End?

A sentence should end with a punctuation mark:

- period (.) for a statement
- question mark (?) for a question
- exclamation point (!) for a sentence that shows excitement

Examples

1] **Tomorrow is Tuesday.**

This sentence ends with a **period** because it is a statement.

2] **Will you come over to my house after school?**

This sentence ends with a **question mark** because a question is being asked.

3] **I got all A's on my report card!**

This sentence ends with an **exclamation point** because it shows excitement.
