What are Adjectives, Adverbs, Antonyms, Synonyms, and Homographs?

Adjectives

An adjective describes a noun or a pronoun.

Examples:

The scared cat hid under the bed.

The word 'scared' describes the cat.

I enjoy being in fourth grade.

The word 'fourth' describes the grade

Adverbs

An adverb

The dog <u>qı</u> 'Quickly' is

Antonyms

Antonyms are words that mean the opposite of each other.

Examples:

Hot and cold are antonyms.

Loud and quiet are antonyms.

Synonyms

Synonyms are words that have almost the same meaning.

Examples:

Little and small are synonyms.

Cold and chilly are synonyms.



Homographs

Homographs are words that have more than one definition.

Examples:

The word nail can mean something you hit with a hammer when building OR a part of your finger or toe.

The worker hammered the <u>nail</u> into the wall.

My sister broke her nail on her pinky finger while playing volleyball.
