

CAUSE AND EFFECT

Cause and effect refers to the relationship between two events.

CAUSE is something that makes something else to happen...an **EFFECT**.

A cause is WHY something happens and an effect is WHAT happened as a result of that cause.

There may be more than one cause or effect in a situation.

Example:

Cause: The grass grew long.

Effect: My Dad cut the grass.

Example:

Fact: There are four seasons: winter, spring, summer, and fall.

Opinion: Fall is the best season.
