### What is Sequence?

SEQUENCE = order

A **sequence** of events is the order in which events occurs.

When you write the steps to the process of a task, the steps should be written in the correct ORDER so that someone can follow the steps to complete the task properly.

If you are telling a story about an incident that took place, it is important to tell the correct sequence of events so people understand the story.

### **How to Brush Your Teeth**

**First**, you put a small amount of toothpaste on your toothbrush.

**Next**, you rinse your mouth out with water and spit into the sink.

**Finally**, you rinse your toothbrush and put it away.
