Are There Any Tricks to Becoming a Successful Speller?

- One technique for successful spelling is to say, or pronounce, the word correctly.
- Another technique for successful spelling is to write the word.
- □ It is helpful to **refer to a dictionary** for the correct spellings of questionable words.
- □ A technique for successful spelling is to **divide the word into parts**, or syllables, and spell it syllable by syllable.
- Another technique for successful spelling is to write the spellings of difficult or often-used words in a notebook.
