What is Descriptive Text?

Descriptive writing appeals to the **senses**. Writers often create a **mood** by choosing specific descriptive words.

Examples:

Descriptive writing can be made more precise by using **exact words**. **Figures of speech**, such as **similes** and **metaphors**, are often used in descriptive writing. A simile is a **comparison** using the words *like* or *as*. A **metaphor** is also a comparison, but the words *like* or *as* are not used in a metaphor.
