

PREPOSITIONS, CONJUNCTIONS, AND INTERJECTIONS

What is a Preposition?

A **preposition** is a connective that shows a relationship between the noun or pronoun following the preposition and another word in the sentence.

What is a Conjunction?

A **conjunction** is a word that connects words, phrases, or simple sentences.

What is an Interjection?

An **interjection** is a word or group of words that expresses strong feelings.
