What is the Internet?

The Internet is a global information system of interconnected computers.

- The letters that are typed in to find a particular website are called the web address.
- A website address that is saved in the computer's memory is called a bookmark.
- A list of website addresses that is saved in the computer's memory is called the Favorites.
- □ An email address contains three parts: the name, the "at" symbol, and the name of the Internet Service Provider.
- Online "rooms" where users can send messages back and forth are known as chat rooms.
- IM stands for Instant Messaging.
- □ A series of letters and/or numbers used on the Internet as a special code is called a password.
