What are Text Features?

The elements of a textbook that are useful in helping to understand the content of the book are called the **text features**.

Examples:

An effective reader uses the **text features** to **preview** the textbook before beginning to read:

- The title page contains the title of the book, the author, the publisher, and the place where the book was published.
- The copyright page contains the date when the book was first published, and the dates of any revisions.
- The glossary contains the definitions of words from the textbook.
- The bibliography lists the titles of the sources used by the author(s) of the book.
