What is Skip Counting?

- Skip counting means you do not say every number as you count.
- You only count special numbers.
- There are many different ways to skip count.

How to Skip Count:

- When counting by twos, you only say every second number.

In this case, you would only say the **bold** numbers. You skip the other numbers.

- When counting by fives, you only say every **fifth** number.
