- $\circ\hspace{0.4cm}$ The dime is also silver, but is smaller than the other coins.
- o It has a picture of Franklin Roosevelt.
- o The dime is worth 10¢ (ten cents).

Quarter



- o The quarter is silver and much larger than the other coins.
- o It has George Washington on one side.
- The quarter is worth 25¢ (twenty-five cents).

How to count coins:

• Since pennies are worth 1¢ each, you can simply count by ones.





 When counting nickels, you can skip count by fives since they are worth 5¢ each.



 You can also skip count when you count dimes. Skip count by tens!




Counting quarters can be a little harder. Since they are worth
