## What are Ordinals?

- An ordinal is an object's position in the order of a group.
- An ordinal tells whether an object is first or fifth.
- Ordinals go as follows:

one = first

two = second

three = third

four = fourth

five = fifth

six = sixth

seven = seventh

eight = eighth

nine = ninth

ten = tenth




