### What are Ordinals?

- An ordinal is an object's position in the order of a group.
- An ordinal tells whether an object is first or fifth.
- Ordinals go as follows:
  - one = first
  - two = second
  - three = third
  - four = fourth
  - five = fifth
  - six = sixth
  - seven = seventh
  - eight = eighth
  - nine = ninth
  - ten = tenth

### How to find the ordinal



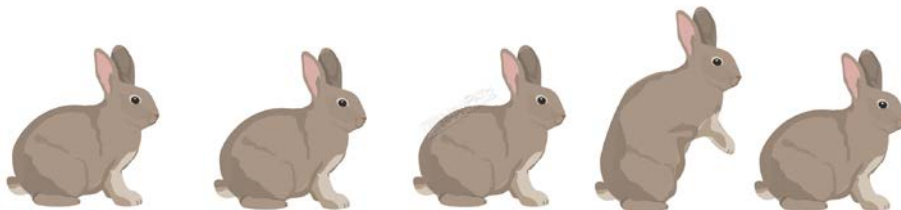

In this set of rabbits, you will see they are facing the other way. The rabbit that is standing up is 2<sup>nd</sup> (second) in line.
