The girl is to the **right** of the boy.

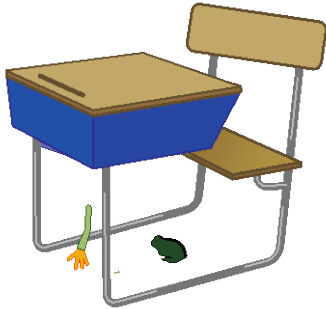
