

COMPARING NUMBERS

When comparing two numbers, you figure out if one number is GREATER or LESS THAN the other number.

You can use SIGNS to show if a number is greater than, less than, or equal to another number:

- > is the sign for greater than
- is the sign for less than

= is

Examples:

16 > 12 ine number 16 is GREATER THAIN the number 12.

4 < 8 The number 4 is **LESS THAN** the number 8.

Examples of comparing number sentences:

$$5 + 2 < 4 + 7$$
 $5 + 2 = 7$ is LESS THAN $4 + 7 = 11$

$$3 + 5 > 2 + 3$$
 $3 + 5 = 8$ is GREATER THAN $2 + 3 = 5$

$$8 + 2 = 5 + 5$$
 $8 + 2 = 10$ is EQUAL TO $5 + 5 = 10$
