

## ORDINAL NUMBERS

**Ordinal** numbers are numbers that are used to tell what order something is in.



There are **five** kids in line at the water fountain.

The girl with the orange shirt is **second** in line.

The boy with the yellow sweater is **third** in line.


The boy with the light blue shirt is **fourth** in line.

The girl with the red shirt is **fifth** in line.

The boy with the green shirt is **fifth** in line.

The **bold, underlined** words above are called **ORDINAL** numbers.

Ordinal numbers tell the **position** of someone or something.

***More Examples of Ordinals:***

If there are five people in front of you in line, you are the **SIXTH** person in line.

If there are six people in front of you in line, you are the **SEVENTH** person in line.

If there are seven people in front of you in line, you are the **EIGHTH** person in line.

If there are eight people in front of you in line, you are the **NINTH** person in line.

If there are nine people in front of you in line, you are the **TENTH** person in line.
