

ODD OR EVEN NUMBERS


- An odd number is a number that will have a leftover when divided into two equal groups.
- An even number is a number that can be divided into two equal groups without any leftovers.

How to Figure Out Odd and Even Numbers:

- To figure out whether a number is odd or even, you simply look at the ones place.
- If the number in the ones place is an even number, then the entire number put together is an even number.

For example:

Since the number in the ones place is a four and the number four is an even number, that makes 354 an even number!

- If the number in the ones place is an odd number, then the entire number put together is an odd number.

For example:

Hundreds	Tens	Ones
8	7	3

Since the number in the ones place is a three and the number three is an odd number, that makes 873 an odd number!
