

DOUBLE DIGIT ADDITION

What Is Double Digit Addition?

- Double digit addition is taking a two digit number (ex. 14) and adding it to another two digit number (ex. 25).
- The answer of these two addends is known as the **sum**.

$$\begin{array}{r} 14 \text{ (addend)} \\ +25 \text{ (addend)} \\ \hline 39 \text{ (sum)} \end{array}$$

How to Do Double Digit Addition:

- When adding numbers with two digits, you begin by adding the ones place first.
