What Is Giving Change?

Change is the money you receive back when you purchase an item and give the cashier more than the item cost.

How to Figure Out Change

To figure out the change you will receive from a purchase, simply **subtract** the total amount of the purchase from the amount you are giving the cashier.

For example:

You pick out a new notebook for school and it costs \$0.45. You give the cashier \$1.00. To figure out how much change you will receive, you need to subtract 45¢ from \$1.00.
