# What Is Giving Change?

Change is the money you receive back when you purchase an item and give the cashier more than the item cost.

## **How to Figure Out Change**

To figure out the change you will receive from a purchase, simply **subtract** the total amount of the purchase from the amount you are giving the cashier.

#### For example:

You pick out a new notebook for school and it costs \$0.45. You give the cashier \$1.00. To figure out how much change you will receive, you need to subtract 45¢ from \$1.00.



### **Try This!**

Figure the amount of change received in each of the following problems.

Molly chooses a pack of stickers for 47¢. She pays the cashier with \$1.00. How much change will Molly receive in return?

Toby brings a small car to the cashier. It costs 83¢. He gives the cashier \$1.00. How much money will Toby receive back from the cashier?
