

## MULTIPLICATION FACTS

- Multiplication is similar to adding a number to itself a certain number of times.
- When multiplying an **odd** number with an **odd** number, the product is always an **odd** number.
- When multiplying an **odd** number with an **even** number or **two even** numbers, the product is always an **even** number.

### How to Multiply:

- Multiplying is the same as taking the first number given and adding it to itself the second number of times.
