What Is Perimeter?

• The perimeter is the measurement of the distance around the **outside** of a shape or object.

How to find the perimeter:

 To find the perimeter of a shape or object, simply add the outside dimensions together.
For example:

12 inches



12 in



12 inches

Each side of this square is 12 inches. To find the perimeter, add 12 + 12 + 12 + 12. The perimeter of this square is 48 inches.



Another example:



To find the perimeter of this triangle, add the dimensions of the three sides together. The perimeter of this triangle is 17 feet.


