

THREE-DIGIT ADDITION

What Is Three-Digit Addition?

Adding large numbers involves breaking the problem down into smaller addition facts.

How to add three-digit numbers:

1. Place one number above the other.
2. Line up the hundreds, tens, and ones places.
3. Draw a line under the bottom number.
4. Add the ones place digits. If this number is larger than 10, place a one above the tens place column and place the ones digit below the line.
5. Add the tens place digits and the one from the previous step. Place the sum below the line.
6. Add the hundreds place digits and the one from the previous step. Place the sum below the line.
7. The thousands place column only has a 1 in it which should be placed below the line in the thousands place column.
