

ROUNDING NUMBERS

What Is Rounding?

- To express a number to the nearest given place.
- Rounding means reducing the digits in a number while trying to keep its value similar.

How to Round:

- The number in the given place is increased by one if the digit to its right is 5 or greater.

- The number in the given place is decreased by one if the digit to its right is 4 or less.

- The digits to the left remain the same.

73 rounded to the nearest ten is 70, because 73 is closer to 70 than to 80.
