What Is Measurement?

The process of measuring

- There are two systems of measurement for length that can be used.
 - **U.S. Customary System**, or English System, is our standard for measuring length. Inches, Feet, and Yards are used in the English System.
 - **Metric System** is the system of measurement based on the meter. Millimeter, Centimeter, and Kilometer are used in the Metric System.

How to Measure

- Use a ruler to measure the length of an object in centimeters and millimeters.
- Determine the length of an object.
