

FOUR-DIGIT ADDITION

How can you add four digit numbers?

Example:

$$4,547 + 2,736$$

Place the first four digit number above the other four digit number so that the thousands, hundreds, tens and ones places are lined up. Draw a line under the bottom number.

Add the ones place digits (7 + 6 = 13). This number is larger than ten so place a one above the tens place column and place the three below the line in the ones place column.

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Add the numbers in the hundreds place column (5 + 7 = 12) and place the two below the line. Place the one from the twelve above the thousands place column.

Add the digits in the thousands place column (1 + 4 + 2 = 7) and place the answer below the line in the thousands place column.
