

COMPARING AND ORDERING NUMBERS

Greater Than or Less Than:

When you are comparing numbers to decide which is greater you need to:

1. Look at the digit in the **HIGHEST place** in both numbers. The highest place is the farthest digit on the LEFT in the number.

Example: Look at these two numbers: 934,901 **7**65,436

They each have a digit in the HUNDRED THOUSANDS place:

2. If the two numbers you are comparing that have the same digit in the same highest place, then you need to look at the **next place**.

Example:

6,740 6,891: Both of these numbers have a 6 in the

THOUSANDS place

6,740 6,891: So we need to look to the HUNDREDS place.

6,**7**40 < 6,**8**91

3. When comparing two numbers, if one number has a digit in a **HIGHER** place than the other number, you know that number is **GREATER**.



Example:

76,902 **9**,876

The first number has a digit (7) in the **TEN THOUSANDS** place.

The second number does **NOT** have a number in the **TEN THOUSANDS** place.

We automatically know then that 76,902 is GREATER than 9,876.

76.902 > 9.876
