What is a Life Cycle?

A **life cycle** is the steps a living thing goes through as it grows from a baby into an adult.

Life Cycle of a Frog

- 1. A frog lays eggs.
- 2. Tadpoles hatch from the eggs.
- 3. Tadpoles grow into adult frogs.

egg → tadpole → adult frog








- 1. A butterfly starts its life as an egg.
- 2. Caterpillars hatch from eggs.
- 3. Some caterpillars grow into a butterfly.



Life Cycle of a Plant

- 1. A plant begins its life as a seed. Inside the seed is a tiny new plant.
- 2. Roots grow from a seed. A stem grows from a seed.
- 3. When a plant starts to grow, it is called a **seedling**. A seedling grows into an adult plant.





Life Cycle of a Chick

- 1. A mother chicken (a hen) lays eggs.
- 2. A baby chick grows inside an egg.
- 3. When the baby chick is ready to be born, the egg hatches.
